#### **Uniforms**

- All students are expected to be in uniform Mondays through Thursdays unless the school has a designated dress-down day. Fridays are designated as "Spirit Wear Day." Students may also dress as they like on Fridays as long as they are following the Marietta City Schools Dress Code Policy. The following describes the Park Street Uniform Policy:
  - Collared shirts: Navy blue, light (powder) blue, yellow, and white. Collared shirts may be longsleeved, short-sleeved, button-up, and/or polo
  - Non-collared shirts: Can be won only in navy or pale yellow
  - Khaki or navy blue pants, skirts, dresses, jumpers, skorts, or shorts
  - All pants must be belted/affixed at the waist and worn with a tucked-in shirt
  - Length of the khaki/navy blue shorts and skirts must be no more than five inches above the knees as measured from the inside bend of the knee
