

## Marietta High School - AP Exam Registration

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Marietta High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. It is also possible that credit earned through AP can allow you to register early at your college, get you into your major coursework earlier, and even allow you to leverage HOPE dollars for graduate degrees.

For the 2019 AP exams, students at Marietta High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

This year each AP exam costs \$98.00, with a one-time service fee of \$15. Marietta High School desires that every student be able to take their AP exams. Students requiring financial assistance should contact Julie O'Meara, Assistant Principal, to learn more.

Online Exam registration will begin on Thu, Jan 3, 2019 at 7:00 AM and end on Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM. In order to register, students should click on [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/111990](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/111990). To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Marietta High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment.

The state will pay for the first math or science exam per student. There is no income requirement. Total Registration will ask you whether or not you are registering for a math or science exam and then it will have to be approved by the school. After approval, your fees will be calculated. This is part of the state's initiative to enroll more students in STEM courses.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Thu, Jan 3, 2019 at 7:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registration Ends
- Thu, Mar 7, 2019 at 12:01 AM - Registrations after this date will no longer be online and will incur a \$40 late fee. Students will inquire at Mrs. O'Meara's office.
- Mon, Mar 11, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.
- Fri, Mar 29, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund.
- Wed, May 1, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam with a cancellation fee of \$30.00.
- The exam window is May 6 – May 17. See the College Board website for the dates and times of specific exams.
