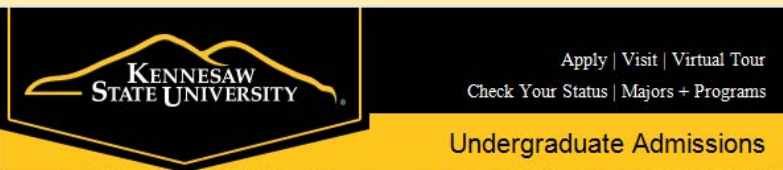

A student will be guaranteed priority class registration if they apply by the priority deadline and they are accepted to the program. **The FINAL DEADLINE is March 15, 2019** for the Fall 2019 DEP academic year.

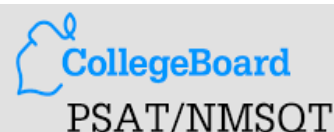

Under "Claim Your Account," click "I don't know my username/password." Enter your student ID number and graduation year. On the Welcome page, change the generated username to your email address.

Once logged in, click "Schedule," then click the red circle (+). Next click "Sign Up" under "Register for Event," and when the calendar page opens, enter the event code above in the field at top left.
