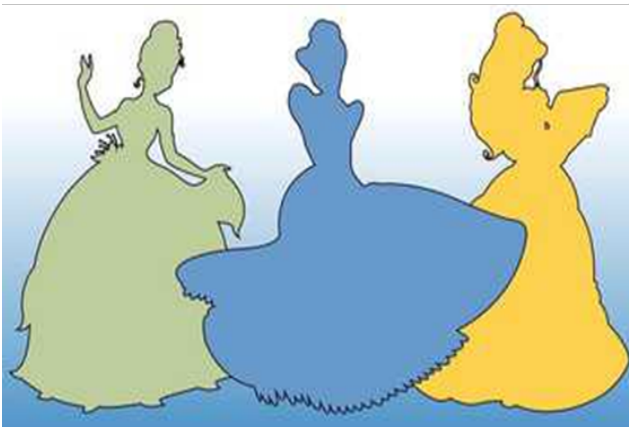

How do I Submit My Senior Quote?

You'll choose a quote to go along with your senior picture, something meaningful or important to you. The Bible, Gandhi, Lincoln, Yoda, whatever. You'll fill this out on a form available at www.mhsolympian.weebly.com. No Kardashians, please. This is due Sunday, September 30.

What do I do if I Haven't Gotten My Senior pictures Made? (3 options)

1. Book a studio appointment at www.cadystudios.com before Sunday, September 30. They have studios in Acworth and Alpharetta. Remember to use promo code marietta10 to save \$10 off the booking session. If you have a financial need, please see your counselor first.
2. Book an appointment at the school. Cady Studios will be here on Thursday, September 13 from 1:00 pm – 6:30 pm. You can book one of these sessions online at www.cadystudios.com. When you do, select only the yearbook and "exposure" scenes. The others won't be available with the on-campus photo sessions. Remember to still use marietta10 as your promo code. If you have a financial need, please see your counselor first.
3. On Tuesday, October 2, Cady Studios will be at the school, taking any remaining senior photos. If option 1 or option 2 doesn't work for you, this is absolutely the last day any senior pictures can be taken. There is no charge for this. Senior must see Mr. Harding during 3A in the media center to reserve a time during the school day. Again, this is your last chance to be included in the yearbook.
