Food pickup in Marietta City Schools: Every Wednesday through July 29th at Marietta Sixth Grade Academy (340 Aviation Road) between 5:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m., first come, first served. The food generally consists of cereal, snacks and other nonperishables; however, there are times when meats and other perishable goods are available. When you come into the school parking lot make a left and drive around to the back of the building and a volunteer will bring the food to your car.
