MAGNET PROGRAM CONTRACT

By choosing to enroll a child in the magnet program housed within MCAA, MSGA and/or MMS, parents provide their child with an exciting educational opportunity. Registration of a student indicates that parents or guardians have accepted the responsibility to provide the proper interest, encouragement, guidance and home environment to foster the best possible learning situation. Parents and students are expected to comply with the requirements of the program. Failure to follow these expectations can result in dismissal. Please read the following expectations carefully and sign the bottom of this contract indicating your understanding of these expectations and intent to comply with them.

1. **Attendance:** I understand that my child is expected to attend school every day, to arrive promptly, and to remain throughout the scheduled hours. Excessive tardies and/or absences will result in my child being placed on attendance probation.
2. I understand that it is my responsibility to notify the school in writing if my child is to be released in the custody of another adult in order to leave school grounds.
3. **Conduct:** I understand that my child is to adhere to the student code of conduct and discipline policies, as well as the requirements for performances and exhibitions of the school. Failure to follow school rules and requirements may result in my child receiving behavioral counseling, being placed on a behavior contract, and/or may result in dismissal from the magnet program.
4. I understand that my child is to adhere to a strict uniform policy, including jackets, sweaters, and belts. Policy details are included in the parent/student handbook.
5. **Parental Support:** I understand that as a parent I must be supportive of my child and his/her school. I understand that I (or an adult representative) am expected to attend parent conferences, my child's performances, exhibitions and other activities sponsored by the school as part of my intent to contribute 20 volunteer hours per year.
6. I understand that it is my responsibility to review, sign and return all homework and communications when requested.
7. **Academics:** I understand that the academic program is challenging and that my child must maintain consistent academic progress and desirable work habits. In order to stay in the magnet program, a student must maintain at least an 80% average of the four core subject area courses. Students who fail to meet the academic expectations will be subject to probation and/or dismissal from the magnet program.
8. **Academic Probation/dismissal:** Grades are available for review in Aspen throughout the year; however, an official Progress Report is provided halfway through each quarter and a Quarterly Report is provided at the end of each quarter. Students who are not meeting the academic expectations described above as reported on the progress report or quarterly report may be placed on *academic probation*. If a student does not meet the academic expectations on any two reports throughout the year, that student may be considered for dismissal from the magnet program.
