Dear MCS Families and Staff,

We have just received new guidance from the Office of the Governor regarding our school closure. Governor Kemp's executive order states that **"schools will remain closed for in-person instruction through April 24th – students may return on Monday, April 27th.** Prior to this date, the Governor will make a decision on the remainder of the school year."

As mandated, Marietta City Schools will remain closed until at least Monday, April 27. As this time period includes our scheduled Spring Break, we intend to honor the time off for our staff and families, and we will not engage in Schoology or other online learning from April 6-10. More information about the extended closure will be provided in our weekly communication update, which will be sent to you by 5:00 p.m. tomorrow (Friday, March 27). I'm sure you have many questions and we will do our best to provide the information we have available at this time.
