



FLOWCHART FOR STUDENTS: COVID-19 CLOSE CONTACT

**STUDENT HAD
CLOSE CONTACT
WITH A CONFIRMED
COVID-19
POSITIVE CASE**

Family immediately notifies principal or school nurse. School nurse confirms case details, conducts contact tracing screening and shares this information with Cindy Davis.

Student develops symptoms or a fever of 100.4 or greater
Family notifies Cindy Davis of change in status.



Cindy Davis informs family of:

- Quarantine period
- Monitoring of symptoms

Cindy adds student's name to contact spreadsheet. Cindy shares parent communication (letter) with school principal or designee.

Student is confirmed COVID-19 positive.

Family notifies Cindy Davis that student has met Return to School eligibility criteria.

RETURN TO SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

If a close contact and not positive for COVID-19, student meets the following:

- Completed 14 days of quarantine after your last contact with COVID-19 positive person; and
- Are symptom free; and
- Have not had any close contact with a COVID-19 positive person while quarantined.

If COVID-19 positive and symptomatic, student meets the following:

- At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication; and
- Symptoms have improved; and
- 10 days since symptoms first appeared.

If COVID-19 positive and asymptomatic, student meets the following:

- 10 days have passed since your positive test.

When positive test results are received, family will be asked to provide confirmation to Cindy Davis. Cindy will provide family with updated isolation guidance.

Nurse Coordinator reports positive results and demographic information to DPH for contact tracing,

Cindy Davis will notify school nurse and administration of the student's eligibility and return to school date.



STUDENT IDENTIFIED AS COVID-19 POSITIVE CASE

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STUDENT IS A CONFIRMED POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE

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Parent immediately notifies principal or school nurse. School nurse confirms case details, conducts contact tracing screening, and shares this information with Cindy Davis.



Cindy Davis works with principal to disseminate close contact, no contact, and/or positive letters to staff/school community



Cindy or designee provides guidance to family regarding next steps:

- Isolation period
- Monitoring of symptoms

Cindy adds student's name to contact spreadsheet



Nurse Coordinator reports positive results and demographic information to DPH for contact tracing



Family notifies Cindy Davis that student has met the Return to School eligibility criteria.

RETURN TO SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

If COVID-19 positive and symptomatic, student meets the following:

- At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication; and
- Symptoms have improved; and
- 10 days since symptoms first appeared.

If COVID-19 positive and asymptomatic, student meets the following:

- 10 days have passed since your positive test.



Cindy Davis will notify school nurse and administration of the student's eligibility and return to school date.
