2. MCS ELA Adoption Process note letter to MCS Staff from Dr. Rivera regarding the ELA Adoption Process

ELA adoption is a process. We are looking at 2 different programs. Some of admin have already looked at the programs. Teachers will be asked to look at both programs. The board will then approve. There will be training on the new ELA program in the summer so that we are ready to roll it out at the beginning of the school year. This program will be k-5.

3. Spanish Assessment for our Dual Language Immersion Students: STAMP Assessment: (Standards-Based Measurement of Proficiency) by <https://avantassessment.com/tests/stamp>

a. STAMP Assessment is used to measure students' ability to use language in the real world in spontaneous interactions.

b. STAMP checks to see if students are “proficient” with the languages you are learning.

c. Assessment is used to earn the Georgia Seal of Biliteracy and/or the Global Seal of Biliteracy on your High School Diploma.

d. Students are assessed in 4 areas: Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening

DLI will take a new assessment. This is the first time that we will have this. Our first DLI cohort will go to fifth grade next year.

4. Student Goal-Setting Activities for each Grade Level

School wide goal setting-3, 4, 5 do really well in setting goals and continuing to conference about the goals throughout the school year. Second grade will start completing goals more like the upper grades. These goals will be communicated with the parents and the students will take ownership of their own goals. Students will write their own goals based on their own personal data. Teachers and students will continue to discuss goals and change if needed.

We will continue to work on writing across all grades and try and incorporate a writing goal for each student.
