2. Academic Program Evaluation: We will look at these programs again and complete a +/- and decide what programs we want to keep and which we do not want. Teachers will look at programs that we have used and

evaluate what we think has worked and not worked. With our new Language Arts program, some of the on line programs will be eliminated. This discussion will continue with leadership and with grade level teams.

3. **Heterogeneous Grouping of Students versus Homogeneous Grouping of Students:** We will relook at the way we group students to make sure we are reaching all of our students and giving them the best possible instruction. Ms. Wright presented some ideas of how she thinks we could group students. This discussion will continue with the leadership team and with the grade level teams.
