 - 1st quarter was a “wash” it was a struggle for both students and teachers--- significant failure rate.
 - No harm policy for 4th quarter ---Draft plan presented in February for 4th quarter
 - Grade recovery at the team level—great participation; study hall—breakout rooms with specific subjects; days 12/4, 12/11, and some teams 12/18. December 11th is the last day for late work.

6. **Pilot Academic Advisor Conversation with Adrian Wright**
 - Summary: First progress reports –need for football players and parents to have clear expectations academically. Conversation led to how tutoring and how parents can help at home and checking in with teachers---missing work, etc.
 - Aspen and Schoology----informing parents and students about grades in Aspen and show them how to find assignments in Schoology.
 - Communication is extremely important. Follow-up is key.
 - Course to start after break—open to athletes— time, organization, how grades affect future grade levels.
 - Check-in with students
 - Next steps: draft of duties and responsibilities to create a supplemental position
