### **4. State of the School:** Virtual Fridays, ACCESS testing, MAP testing-Prelim overview of results, Demographics-Attendance-Climate, District COVID-19 CTT contact, Health and Mitigation Update (NBPI) & Universal Precautions

\*Virtual Fridays-option for staff until February 19th then re-evaluate. Staff are still working and available 8:15-4:15pm. SGT members agree with keeping the option for virtual Fridays

\*Access testing is starting and has to be in person. 103 students will be tested. Transportation is available

\*MAP testing results –results are coming in. Over 200 students have showed growth from Fall to Winter. Testing will finish today (1/22). Students earned dress down days if they had growth. Highest growth student on each team will get a PBIS gift basket. Working with students with low RIT to help them grow. ELA and Math—goal setting needed in the upcoming weeks. This will be recorded in the platform.

\*Possibly adding Science back to MAP testing for next year.

\*Promote/retention: revised requirements. MAP will be used as a data point. MILESTONES will not have much weight. Last year 8 students retained.

\*9 different languages represented in our school. Demographic data presented.

\*Attendance: 93.6%, 30% of families are virtual

\*Climate: 2 referrals as of 1/21, teachers setting expectations, positive climate.

\*COVID information: district tracing teams.

\*Health: Needlepoint air filter systems installed at MSGA in December. Universal precautions being used---6 feet, cleaning, masks, time with others, etc. Data can be sent if you need it.

\*New Teacher Facilitator Mid-year update: One-to-one meetings, monthly meetings, continual/ongoing help with Aspen, Schoology, etc. Checklist sent to new teachers if they need help. Will continue to pass along PD opportunities for new teachers.

\*Tutoring: looking at qualifying students. EL and team 6-6 math focus. Mr. Wright will continue to help—focus on football and basketball players. Creating a Schoology course—Academics and Athletics to meet with students. Possibly grow this to an athletic advisor and a non-athletic advisor
