1. **Call To Order** by Lawson at 7:47 am
2. **Review And Approval of Agenda** No questions or issues regarding agenda items below from the team
3. **Minutes-Completed, available and posted**
4. **State of the School: Academic overview-AS-Advanced Studies** probation process moving forward, low percentage of students impacted less than 5% **OL-Passing rates** on par with AS, need to ensure equal opportunities are available and provided for OL students regardless of team or content (i.e. PLC) both McCullar and Scott agreed and believe that adjusting PLC focus to leverage equal focus will help primarily for Science and possibly for SS. **Fall Tutoring-** Approximately 70 students participating, students served on a needed-basis and targeted service such as ESOL, SWD and Connections. **EBD SC Class**-new unit open and staffed based on identified IEP needs of qualifying students to promote opportunities for success. **1st Quarter Zero-Pass Celebration**-Edwards able to provide summary that 83% of students have qualified to participate in courtyard games, snacks and social time on 11/18 for having no major or minor referrals and passing all core content courses.
 - MMG Walkthroughs**-Both MMS and MSGA Principals conducting joint informal classroom walkthroughs for awareness and open-dialogue to bridge expectations around instruction, teaching and learning between both buildings. Began this week at MMS and will continue next week at MSGA. The walks will continue into the Spring and incorporate other staff over time and include the MHS Principal.
 - MSGA Giving Opportunity: MSGA Thanksgiving Basket**-The Team unanimously open to gift cards for needy families. Lawson will pick the cards up and deliver to the MSGA Counseling Dept.
 - Safety Review: Locked/Never Propped etc.**-Safety drills continuing and on-going efforts to keep our campus safe. Staff trained by district office and priority given to ensure all doors and window in need of repairs occur immediately. Three A-Team members now have rights to submit work orders when needed.
5. **Policy updates and Revisions: MSGA Field Trips/Background checks vs. Raptor Alerts, MCS Attendance Policy Revisions**-Highlights of both policies and processes shared by Lawson.
6. **Discussion to amend unified dress code: PTSA request: Bring back hoodies**-The Team on board with aligning PTSA across MMG requirements. Barnett and Lawson shared past history of why hoodies went off of the list. No objections voiced regarding hooded sweatshirts being added as clothing on the uniform list.
