HB 287 training for Staff and presentation for students-excerpt from parent

letter: *HB287 also requires state boards of education to prescribe a course of study about human trafficking awareness for students in grades 6-12. Changes to state curriculum standards have occurred to reflect the newly adopted legislation. Marietta City Schools is partnering with Susan Norris and Rescuing Hope (a local non-profit organization) to provide instruction in human trafficking awareness to students in grades 6-12 through the Play it Safe presentation. Student presentations, approximately one hour in length, will occur by grade level and are slated to begin in January 2023. All grade level presentations should conclude by the beginning of February. Rescuing Hope teaches middle and high school students how to Play it Safe by sharing age-appropriate facts, stories, and actionable tips that can help them avoid dangerous situations and empower them to protect themselves and those around them from falling victim to a trafficker. Students will learn:*

- *What sex trafficking is and how it works.*
- *Who traffickers target, where, and how.*
- *How to safely use social media and technology.*
- *Simple ways to protect themselves from being exploited.*
- *How to recognize when someone is being trafficked or at risk of being trafficked.*
- *Who to call if they suspect someone is being trafficked.*
- *What they and their friends can do to fight sex trafficking.*
