- 5. Discussion:** **MSGA Unified Dress Code/MMS changes and alignment- During the February 2023 MMS SGT meeting, revisions were made to the school's unified dress code. Overall, the updated changes clearly align with MSGA's unified dress code including any Marietta City Schools shirt/t-shirt/sweatshirt/hooded sweatshirt. Outerwear may be MCS or solid colors of blue, black, gray or white only. The updated MMS unified dress code pants options that include blue, black or gray solid joggers, long shorts, skorts (at least 4 inches above the knee), sweatpants, leggings, khakis, jeans (without rips, fraying or fringes). Based on input from Istas and Edwards, MMS students are also allowed to wear 'Croc-like' (foam molded) slippers and slides. The MSGA SGT considered adopting pants and footwear options mentioned above. 4-0 in agreement that MSGA should adopt as well.
